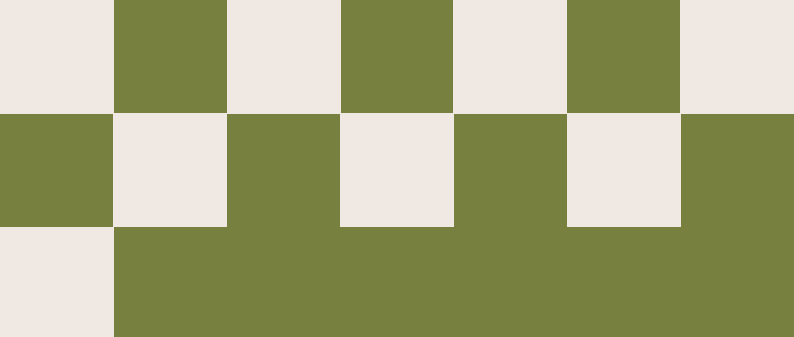
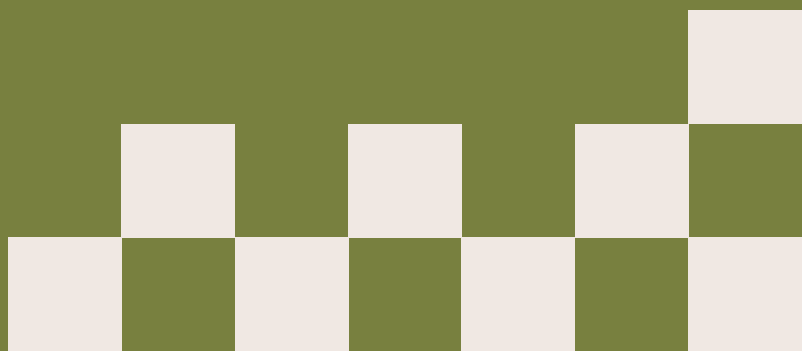

Break in Classic Festival

Break in Classic is a classical music festival.

Classical music is often associated with:

- orchestra,
- philharmonic hall,
- old music,
- serious concerts.

Sometimes people think that classical music is difficult to understand.

We want to change that!

The festival will help you learn about classical music.
During the festival you will hear old and new pieces.
We will play old pieces in a new way.

At the festival you will discover the beauty of old music.
We want to show you that classical music is interesting.
You can listen to it in different ways.

They work on the festival programme.

Where is the festival?

The festival is held on the grounds of the Museum of Interiors in Otwock Wielki.

The Museum takes care of the palace and the park.
The palace and the park are on an island.
The island is on Lake Rokola.

When is the Break in Classic festival?

The festival lasts 3 days:

- July 31, Friday from 4:45 PM until the evening.
- August 1, Saturday from 5:00 PM until the evening.
- August 2, Sunday from 3:00 PM until the evening.

What can you do during the festival?

At the festival you can:

- listen to concerts,
- meet the artists,
- visit the museum,
- dance at a silent disco.

Silent disco is a dance party.
Participants of the party receive headphones.
They hear music in the headphones.

Internet and phone

Your phone may not work on the festival grounds.
You may have problems with phone reception.

There will be no place to charge your phone at the festival.

Therefore, before you arrive:

- charge your phone,
- download the ticket to your phone or print the ticket,
- plan your arrival and return,
- write down important phone numbers.

Payments

At the festival you can pay with:

- cash,
- card,
- banking app.

Remember: sometimes you may have problems
with card payment or payment via a banking app.



What might you need at the festival?

How you prepare depends on you and the weather.

During the festival you may need:



Cash



Head covering



Drinking water

Important: You can bring a 0.5 liter bottle with you.



Sunscreen



Rain cape or umbrella



Mosquito repellent



Blanket



Comfortable clothing and shoes



Flashlight



Remember your ID

Bring your photo ID with you.

You will need the document when you enter the festival grounds.

What can't you bring?

Do not bring food with you.

This rule does not apply to:

- baby food.
- food that you need due to your health.

The organizer may ask you for a doctor's note.

Do not bring the following to the festival:

- drinks other than water in a small bottle,
- glass bottles,
- alcohol and drugs,
- large bags,
- camera with interchangeable lenses,
- camera tripods,
- selfie sticks.

Forbidden are:

- weapons and explosives,
- lasers,
- fireworks,
- drones.

Security checks what you have with you when you enter the festival.

Do not bring animals to the festival.

The festival is loud and there are many people.

****This rule does not apply to people with an assistance dog.**

****An assistance dog may enter the festival.**

Festival Staff

- **Festival security employees**

You will meet them at the entrance gate
and at the festival entrance.
And at the festival stages.

Security employees wear uniforms.
They have badges with the inscription SECURITY.

- **Festival team**

You will meet them at the information point.
And at the ticket-to-wristband exchange point.
They are also in the festival office in the palace

Employees have badges
with the inscription: ORGANIZER.

- **Female volunteers**

You will meet them on the festival grounds.
Female volunteers have badges and red t-shirts.

The t-shirts have the inscription:
Muzeum Narodowe w Warszawie
(National Museum in Warsaw).

- **Museum staff and security**

You will meet them in the palace,
for example during guided tours.

- **Medical services**

You will meet them on the festival grounds.
There is a medical patrol at the festival.
The medical point is near the parking lot.



Getting to the festival

Arrive at the festival grounds before the first concert.
Plan your route.

Take the information below into account.

You cannot reach the festival grounds by public transport.

Train, Bus

The nearest train station: Otwock.

The station is about 8 kilometers from the festival grounds.

The nearest bus stops are in Otwock or Karczew.

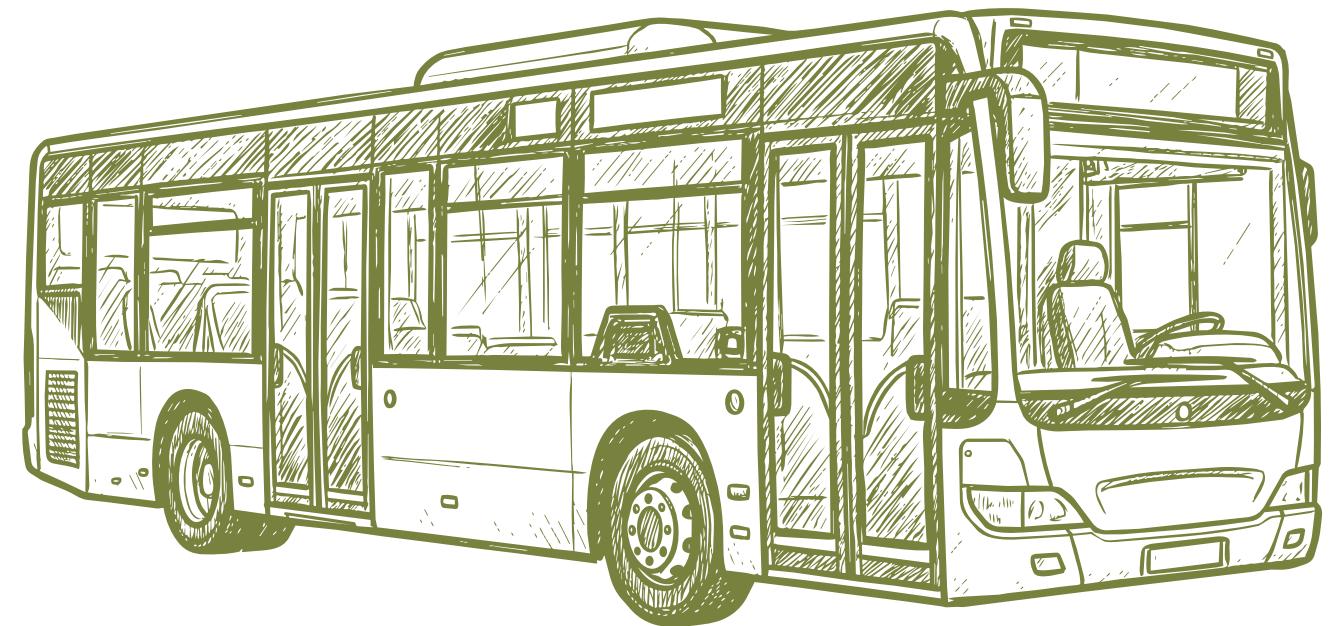
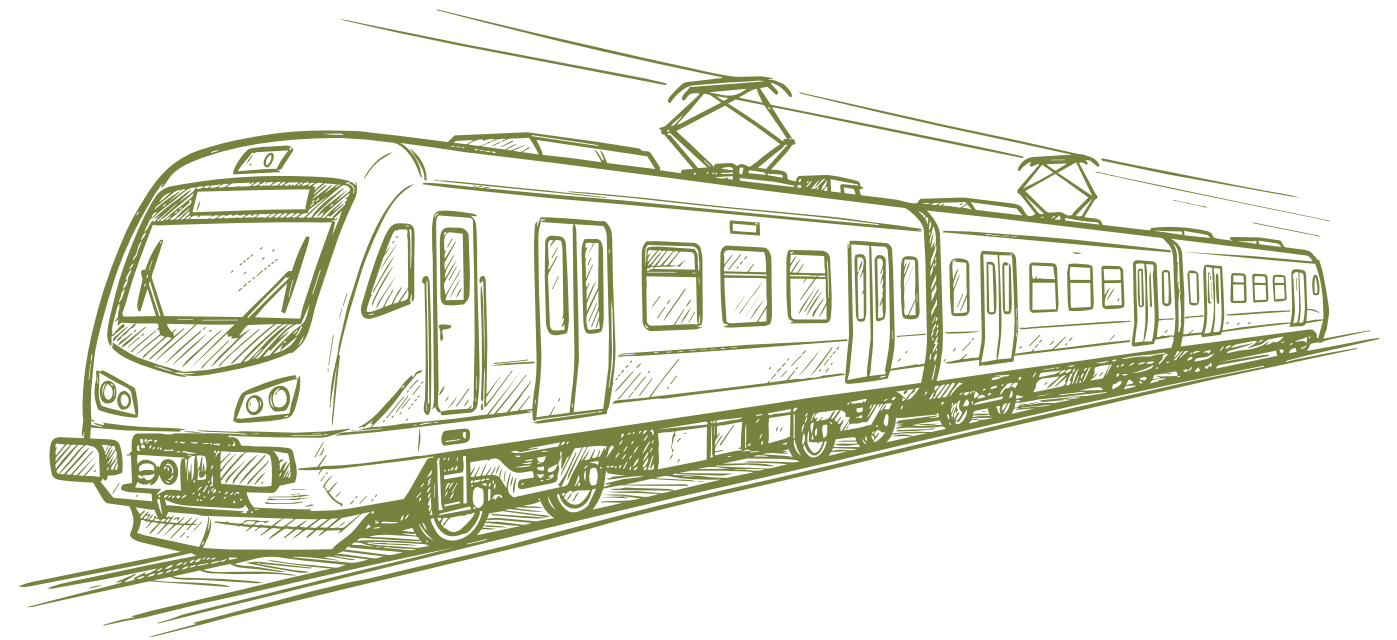

The walk from the nearest station or stop takes about 1.5 hours.

Bicycle, scooter and rollerblades

You cannot ride a bicycle or scooter on the festival grounds.
You also cannot use rollerblades.

Leave your bicycle or scooter in the parking lot.
There are bicycle racks there.



Entrance gates

You can enter the parking lot through 2 entrance gates:

1. Main Gate
2. VIP Gate, for people with disabilities and for the media.

The gates are on Zamkowa Street.

There will be signposts in the vicinity of the festival grounds. Security will direct car and bicycle traffic.

The gates will be open:

- July 31, Friday from 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM
- August 1, Saturday from 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM
- August 2, Sunday from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM.



Parking

The parking lot is on Zamkowa Street.
The parking lot is behind the entrance gate.
The walk from the parking lot to the stage takes about 15 minutes.

Parking is paid. You must buy a ticket.
The number of spaces is limited.

Parking ticket

You must have a parking ticket.
A separate one for each day of the festival.

You can buy a ticket on the e-bilet website:

Download the parking ticket to your phone or print it.
Show it to security at the gate.

**If there are free spaces in the parking lot,
you can buy a ticket on site.**

You can do this at the gate, from a security employee.

Parking for people with disabilities

If you have a ticket for people with disabilities,
you can use a separate parking lot.

This parking lot is close to the entrance to the festival grounds.
A security employee will show you the parking space.

People with an assistant ticket can park
in the parking lot for people with disabilities.

Important: You must have a parking ticket.
A separate one for each day of the festival.

For people with disabilities and assistants
the parking ticket is free.

VIP Parking

If you have a VIP ticket, you can use a separate parking lot.
VIP parking is free.

Apply for a VIP parking ticket by writing to:

Festival bus

The bus takes the audience to the festival.
You can board the bus in front of the National Museum
in Warsaw.

The Museum is at Aleje Jerozolimskie 3.

The bus ride is free.
You don't have to pay for it.
You must have a festival ticket.

Do you want to take the bus?

Bus timetable

July 31 and August 1

**Departures from Warsaw at 2:30 PM and 3:00 PM.

Departures from the festival grounds at 9:30 PM and 11:15 PM.

2 buses depart every hour.

1 bus is always available for people in wheelchairs.

August 2

Departure from Warsaw at 12:30 PM and 1:00 PM.

2 buses depart every hour.

1 bus is always available for people in wheelchairs.

Departure from the festival grounds around 7:30 PM.

4 buses depart at this time.

2 buses are then available for people in wheelchairs.

Entrance to the festival grounds

The entrance is on Zamkowa Street.
Right next to the entrance to the island.

Ticket exchange tents

There are tents at the entrance.
In the tents you can exchange your ticket
or pass for a festival wristband.
There are different tents for exchanging different tickets.

In a separate tent you can exchange:

- 1-day festival ticket,
- 2-day festival ticket,
- full festival pass.

Come early!

There may be many people at the tents.
Therefore, we encourage you to come to the festival earlier.

VIP, people with disabilities and media service tent

If you have a VIP ticket or a ticket for
a person with a disability,
use a separate wristband exchange tent.



Festival wristband

Exchange your ticket for a festival wristband.
We will put the wristband on your arm.

You can exchange your ticket for a festival wristband:

- July 31, Friday from 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM.
- August 1, Saturday from 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM.
- August 2, Sunday from 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM.

You must wear the wristband throughout the festival.
This is important if you are at the festival for more than 1 day.
In this case, do not remove the wristband
after leaving the festival grounds.

Important: Do not give the wristband to another person.

What to prepare before exchanging your ticket for a wristband

Prepare:

- festival ticket,
- ID document, e.g. identity card.

Do you have a ticket for a person with a disability?

Additionally, prepare the disability certificate.

Do you have a ticket for an assistant of a person with a disability?

You can enter the festival grounds only with the person
you are assisting.

The person you are assisting
must have a ticket for a person with a disability.



Did you tear or damage your wristband?

Only people with a wristband can be at the festival.
Show your wristband every time you enter the festival.

If the wristband breaks at the festival, do not throw it away
Go to security immediately.

Show the torn wristband to security.
Security will tell you what to do.

Important: You will only receive a new wristband
if you damaged the wristband on the festival grounds.

Wristband for a child

Everyone at the festival must have a festival wristband.

Children can have an additional wristband.
You will receive such a wristband when exchanging your ticket.
Write the guardian's phone number on it.



Festival gates

At the gate, a security employee will check your wristband.

The security employee may ask you to show what you have in your bag or backpack.

We do this for the safety of everyone at the festival.

Info point

The information point is on the festival grounds.
It stands next to the palace.

The staff at the point will be happy to answer all your questions.
You can borrow an induction loop at the point.



Museum of Interiors in Otwock Wielki

The festival is held on the grounds of the Museum of Interiors in Otwock Wielki.

The museum is in an old palace.

You can visit the exhibitions in the palace for free.

You do not have to register in advance.

The exhibitions are open:

- July 31, Friday from 3:00 PM to 8:00 PM.
- August 1, Saturday, from 3:00 PM to 8:00 PM.
- August 2, Sunday from 1:00 PM to 6:00 PM.

On the Break in Classic festival website there are:

- audio guide with audio description
- guide in Polish Sign Language.

Palace accessibility

The exhibitions are on the ground floor and the first floor.

There is no elevator in the palace.

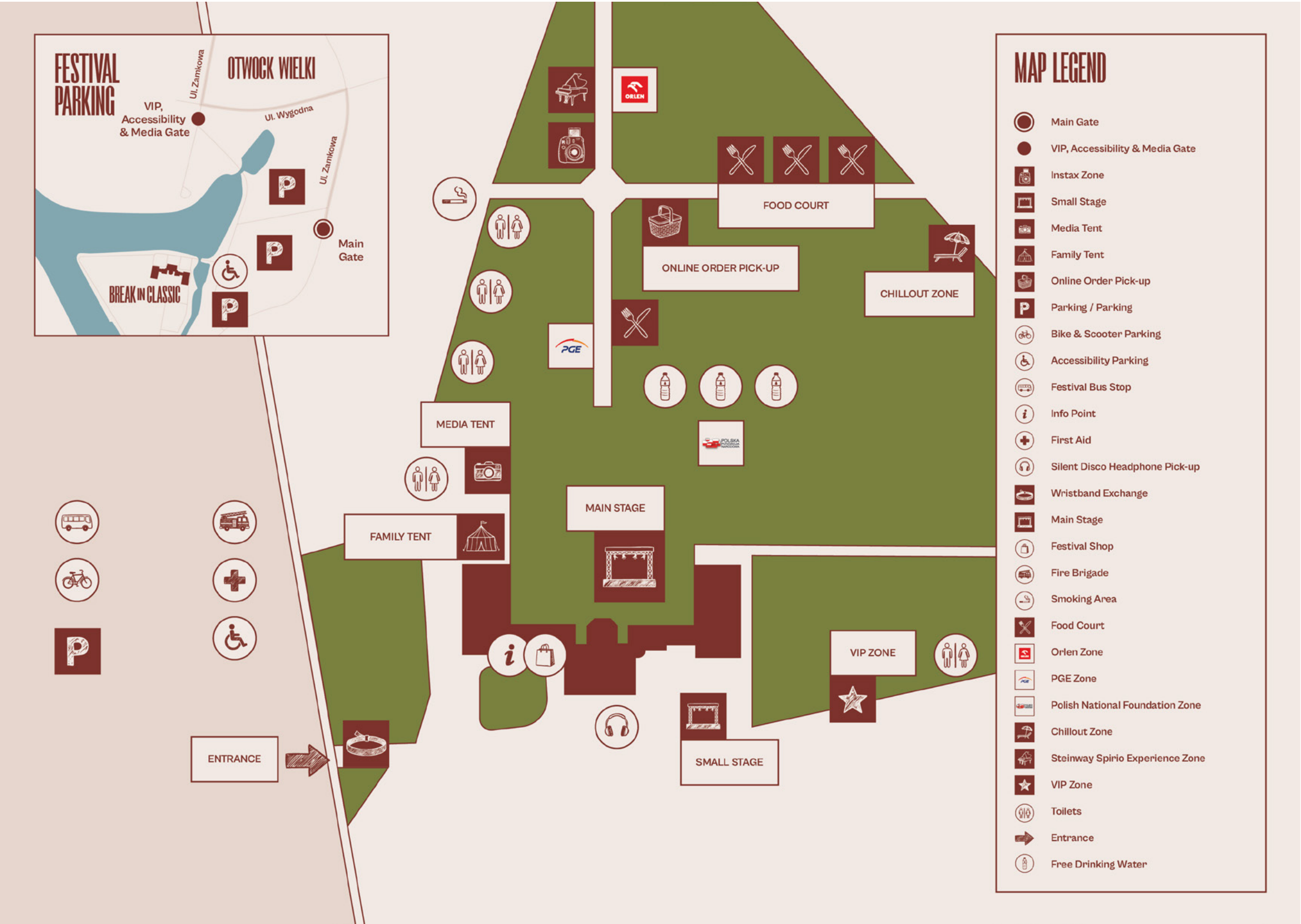
You can only go up to the first floor by stairs.

Some doors in the palace are narrow and have a threshold.



Festival grounds

The festival is next to the palace and in the park.



Festival stages

There are 2 stages at the festival:

1. **The Small Stage** is near the entrance to the palace.
Meetings with artists take place on the small stage.
2. **The Main Stage** is on the other side of the palace.
That is, on the park side.

Concerts take place on the main stage.

Seating areas

Seating areas near the stages are not numbered.
Choose the spot you want.

Sit on a chair or deckchair.
Or spread out your blanket.

There is no roofing near the stages.



Family tent

The family tent is in the park, close to the main stage.

In the tent you can feed and change your child.

In the tent there are:

- sink,
- changing table,
- seating areas.

Festival shop

The festival shop is close to the entrance to the palace.
You will see it right after entering the festival grounds.

In the shop you can buy:

- festival gadgets,
- e.g. t-shirts or bags,
- CDs with artists' music.



Drinking water

There are places with free water on the festival grounds.

Food zone

Food and drink stalls are in the park, next to the paths.

Toilets

The toilets are in the park.

Along the path by the lake.

This path starts at the entrance to the festival grounds.

The family tent is next to this path.

Portable toilets are located there.

Some of them are accessible for people with disabilities.

The places are:

- close to the festival entrance,
- near the palace, close to the main stage.



Chillout zone

The relaxation zone is in the park.
Behind the food and drink stalls.

The relaxation zone has deckchairs and benches.
There are many tall trees there that provide shade.

In this zone you can:

- rest,
- calm down,
- take a break from festival events.

The relaxation zone is next to the path in the park.
Other people may walk along the path.
Therefore, the relaxation zone may be calmer
than near the stage, but it will not always be quiet.



Festival accessibility

Festival grounds

On the festival grounds there are:

- asphalt paths,
- sand roads,
- roads with large stones,
- lawns.

The paths in the park have curbs.

The area near the main stage is uneven.

There is a lawn there.

It may be slippery after rain.

Assistance at the festival

Volunteers will help you move around the area.

If you need support:

- Mention it when exchanging your ticket for a wristband

Induction loop

The loop works during:

- concerts,
- meetings with artists,
- silent disco.

You can rent the loops at the information point.

Toilets

There are portable toilets on the festival grounds, including toilets for people with disabilities.

A toilet for people with disabilities is also on the ground floor of the palace.

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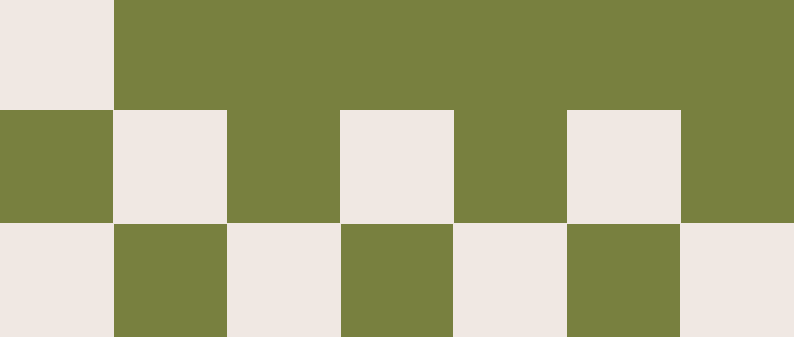
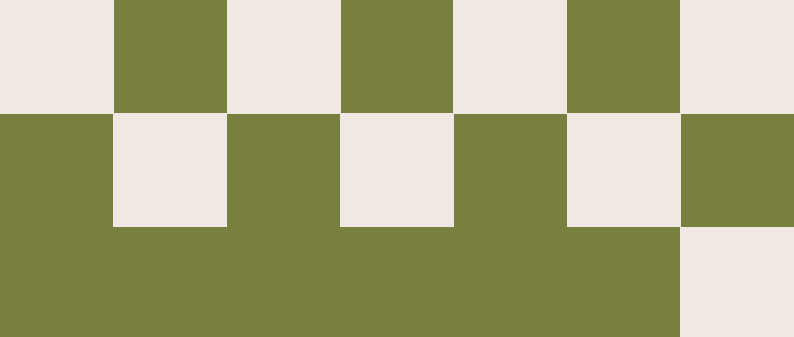
